
c) Giving directions! Translate the following sentences.

3. Giving directions.

a) Fill in the instructions with suitable words according to the map.

1. **Excuse me, how can I get to the post office?**

Walk **ALONG** Violet Street. Take the first turning **ON THE RIGHT**. Go **STRAIGHT ON / AHEAD**. It's on your left **BETWEEN** the restaurant and the hospital.

2. **Sir, can you tell me the way to the CAR PARK?**

Of course. **GO** down Lily Street. Turn left **INTO** Daisy Street. Go straight on. Take the **SECOND** turning on the left. It's on your left between the amusement park and the greengrocer.

3. **Excuse me, is there a cinema **NEAR** here?**

Yes, go down Lily Street. At the junction, turn left, go **PAST** the bank and it's right there, on your right, on the **CORNER** of Daisy Street and Rose Street.

4. **Can you help me, please? I'm lost and I would like to go to the gas station.**

Certainly, it's not far. Go **STRAIGHT** ahead along Violet Street. Take the first turning on the left. It's right there, **OPPOSITE** the park.
